

GRADUATING DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENTS SUMMER TERM A – ADMISSIONS PROCESS

St. Johns River State College has a procedure to allow Dual Enrollment students who will graduate from high school in the spring to enroll during the summer term. Students must demonstrate they have performed college-level equivalent work to begin attending courses in the Summer A term. Students will be required to complete a readmission application and to submit a separate request for the opportunity to take courses in the Summer A term. Enrollment under this exception is for Summer A only.

If you wish to attend courses under this exception, you must send your request to the Office of Student Affairs for approval. The following are required before a decision is made to enroll:

- 1. Complete an online Readmission Application on or before April 22, 2026.
- 2. Submit a statement explaining why the student wishes to begin classes early (i.e., before high school graduation).
- 3. Provide a letter or email from the high school guidance office that confirms that the student is eligible to graduate in the current academic year. The letter must include the date of expected graduation.

In order for a request for early admission to be approved, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. Earned at least 12 credit hours as a Dual Enrollment student while attending high school. These courses and credit hours cannot include AP / AICE / IB or other equivalent programs; they must be earned as Dual Enrollment credits.
- 2. Earned at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA on the college equivalent coursework completed as a Dual Enrollment student.

PLEASE NOTE: The Readmission Application must be submitted no later than **April 22, 2026.** The student statement and letter from the high school counselor must be received in the Office of Student Affairs no later than **Friday, May 1, 2026.** Students needing assistance with their course schedule are encouraged to call the Dual Enrollment Office at (386) 312-4136 and speak with a Dual Enrollment Specialist. If admitted for Summer Term A, the student will be responsible for tuition, fees, and books.

Please note that financial aid will not be provided for the semester you seek early enrollment. Once you are admitted as a traditional student and have provided an official final high school transcript, you may apply and be considered for financial aid. Bright Futures can only be awarded during the Summer B term, and only the Academic Scholars and the Medallion Scholars will pay for summer coursework. Any other Bright Futures scholarships will not pay in the summer term.
