



If you are a high school student in Clay, Putnam, or St. Johns County, you can ease your transition to college with SJR State's Dual Enrollment program. Dual Enrollment allows students to get ahead on college courses while still in high school.

### **DUAL ENROLLMENT**

Dual Enrollment provides eligible accelerated high school students the opportunity to simultaneously earn both college credit and a high school diploma.

### **EARLY ADMISSION**

Early Admission is a form of dual enrollment which allows eligible high school junior and senior students to enroll in only college level courses, students take these courses in place of their high school courses.

#### **EARLY COLLEGE PROGRAM**

## (previously known as the Collegiate High School)

This program allows admitted students to complete 60 credits of dual enrollment coursework, culminating in earning both a standard high school diploma as well as an Associate of Arts (AA) Degree upon the completion of four years of high school. SJR State offers this program in Clay County at Middleburg High School and Orange Park High School, in Putnam County at Interlachen High School and Palatka High School, and in St. Johns County at Pedro Menendez High School and Tocoi Creek High School. This program is limited acceptance and students must meet specific criteria in order to be eligible to participate.

**November 30** – Deadline for Spring online application

**April 15** – Deadline for Summer online application
