Scholarships of \$500 each will be awarded to a qualified applicant chosen by Altrusa International of St. Augustine, Inc. and given final approval by Linda Robison.

An applicant should be:

- a resident of St. Johns County who plans to remain in the area.
- a non-traditional student (out of high school for six or more years) who seeks to upgrade work skills in a tech school or college to seek an undergraduate degree.
- an individual who has serious financial need.

Non-traditional students who wish to be considered must:

- (1) Complete the application form.
- (2) Ask **two** people to submit recommendations on the provided form. Each person should be a professional with knowledge of the applicant's academic grades and be familiar with the applicant's academic ability and commitment to finishing a degree. Recommendations from family members will not be considered.

The applicant should give the form to the individuals who will make a recommendation. The person completing the recommendation should mail the reference directly to the Altrusa club.

A complete application packet is the application form and two (2) completed recommendations. Incomplete packets will not be considered. Applicants may need to follow-up with people asked to make references to be sure the recommendations are mailed on time.

All applicants will be notified as soon as possible following the committee's decision which will be made at Altrusa's District 3 Conference, April 24-26, 2025.
